FIELD TRIP: Exploring the Lower Genesee River

Departure: 10:30 a.m.

PRESENTERS: Jutta Siefert Dudley, Ph.D, SUNY College at Brockport and Dan Robertson, Ph.D, Monroe Community College

Join two avid geologists in a journey along the lower Genesee River, Lake Ontario and Irondequoit Bay as you learn about the history of the river and its impact on the people who settled there. The geological focus on this trip is the Pleistocene history of the river and surrounding region and the story of the Ordovician through Silurian periods. You'll enjoy

learning about these topics as you visit the Rochester gorge to see its waterfalls and well-exposed Paleozoic strata, the harbor and lake shore beaches, and a bay holding secrets to the river's past. Educational handouts will be supplied.

Come prepared for rain or shine. You must bring your own lunch. A cooler, water, and snacks will be provided. We will travel by bus and spend time at several stops. The walking is easy to moderate.
