FIELD TRIP: Exploring the Glacial Landscape of Monroe County

Join us in a journey across the glacial landscape surrounding Rochester. The features that abound here, eskers, kames, kettles, bogs, recessional moraines, lakebeds, drumlins, plus a remarkable river gorge, reveal the dramatic story of the last Ice Age's receding glacier. Many of these prized

features are found in Mendon Ponds Park, a nationally recognized natural landmark.

We will make several stops, most with minimal walking. At Mendon Ponds, be prepared to walk along dirt trails with some short, steep inclines.

Educational handouts will be supplied.

Come prepared for rain or shine. You must bring your own lunch. We will provide water and snacks.
